## Michigan Collaborative Standardization of Compounded Oral Liquids

Drug name: Allopurinol Dosage Form: Suspension

**Concentration:** 20 mg/ml **Shelf Life:** 60 days

Route: Oral Storage: Refrigerate or Room temp

Volume: 100 ml Auxiliary Labeling: Shake Well

Ingredients	QS	Quantity	Units
Allopurinol 100 mg tablets		20	tablets
Ora-Blend or substitute Ora-Plus/Ora-Sweet	Υ	100	mLs

## **Directions:**

- 1. Crush tablets in a mortar and pestle and triturate to a fine powder.
- 2. Add a minimal amount of vehicle and mix well to form a viscous, but smooth and uniform paste.
- 3. Continue adding vehicle in geometric portions, mixing well.
- 4. Transfer to graduate.
- 5. Rinse mortar several times with vehicle; adding rinse to graduate. Stir well.
- 6. There will be a loss in total volume due to the thickness of suspension. Do not QS to final volume.

## Notes:

• Final product is a thick, opaque, white suspension.
