Ora-Blend (or 1:1 Ora-Plus/Ora-Sweet)	Х	100	mL

Directions:

- 1. Withdraw nifedipine liquid from capsules using needle and syringe.
- 2. Measure the required amount of nifedipine liquid and add to mortar.
- 3. Add vehicle in geometric proportions and mix well.
- 4. Transfer to a graduated cylinder, rinse mortar with vehicle.
- 5. Add QS of vehicle to final volume (100 mL).

Notes:

For most effective withdrawal, puncture opposite side of capsule prior to extraction.
