Directions:

- 1. Mix Ora-Plus and Ora-Sweet thoroughly, using a glass mortar and pestle, in geometric proportions, to prepare the vehicle.
- 2. Triturate the tablets into a fine powder and levigate with a small proportion of the vehicle into a smooth suspension
- 3. Add the vehicle in geometric proportions with constant mixing.
- 4. Transfer to a graduated cylinder.
- 5. Rinse the mortar and pestle with sufficient vehicle and transfer to graduated cylinder to make up the final volume.

This formulation was stored in amber prescription bottles.
