Directions:

- 1. Empty contents of capsules into a mortar.
- 2. Add a minimal amount of Ora-Plus and mix well to form a smooth, thick paste.
- 3. Continue adding Ora-Plus in geometric portions, mixing well.
- 4. Transfer mixture to prescription bottle and QS to a final volume of 50 mLs by rinsing mortar and pestle with small amounts of strawberry syrup.

Notes:

• Each mL provides 10 mg of elemental zinc.
